The question again recurred on assenting to the resolution as amended,

And on being put,

It was assented to and sent to the Senate.

Mr. Graves presented the petition of James Robertson, praying indemnification for purposes therein mentioned;

Read and referred to the committee on Grievances and Courts

of Justice.

Mr. Tuck submitted the following message:

By the House of Delegates, December 31st, 1842.

Gentlemen of the Senate:

We have appointed Messrs. Tuck and Roberts on the part of this House, to join the gentlemen who may be named by your honorable body, to carry into effect the provisions of resolution No. 8, of December session 1840.

Which was read, assented to and sent to the Senate.

Mr. Nicols presented the petition of Bromwell Andrew and William R. Andrew, of Caroline county, praying to make valid their title to a certain tract of land therein mentioned;

Read and referred to Messrs. Nicols, Tuck and Sherwood of

Caroline.

Mr. Crampton presented the petition of the grand and petit jurors of Frederick county court, for October term 1842, praying for the act therein mentioned;

Read and referred to Messrs. Crampton, Richardson and Mc-

Keehan.

Mr. Tuck presented the petition of Jonathan Prout and wife and Thomas T. Gantt and others, praying that a case may be reinstated in the Court of Appeals, which was dismissed because the record was not transmitted by the Register in Chancery within the time limited by law;

Read and referred to the committee on Grievances and Courts

of Justice.

Mr. Grove submitted the following order:

Ordered, That the committee on Internal Improvement be instructed to inquire of the President of the Chesapeake and Ohio Canal Company, what amount of canal scrip has been received as tolls on the Chesapeake and Ohio Canal from the 1st day of January, 1842, up to the 25th of December of the same year; and if any has been received, what amount, and what disposition has been made of the same;

Which was read.

The following amendment to said order was read and assented

"And also, whether any officer of said company, toll gatherer or agent, is engaged in the business of boating on the said canal, and if so, what is the probable amount paid by said officer, toll
