The Speaker laid before the House the following communication from the Treasurer of the Western Shore :

WESTERN SHORE TREASURY,
Annapolis, 17th Feb., 1843.

To the Honorable

The House of Delegates:

In obedience to their order of the 13th instant, the Treasurer furnishes the accompanying "statement of the condition of the tobacco inspection fund," shewing that of the last year's revenue, the sum of \$3,563⁴⁰/₁₀₀ was disbursed for redemption of the debts incurred for the tobacco warehouses, per chapter 252 of 1826, and chapter 350 of 1835, and its supplements, leaving in the Treasury 1st December last, the balance of \$10,705³⁹/₁₀₀, set forth in his printed annual report, among the charges upon the general balance in the Treasury on that day.

That balance also, is, in virtue of resolution No. 40 of 1834, applicable to the credit of the sinking fund, for the redemption of the said debts, and will be so applied by the Treasurer as fast as he can purchase the securities.

The revenue for the quarter ended 1st instant, having been, as is shewn, insufficient to pay the current charges, the balance in the Treasury 1st December last, was reduced on the 9th instant, to \$9,459⁵⁵/₁₀₀. Which is respectfully submitted,
