

The bill entitled, an act granting further time to William Sewell, collector of the county charges for the third collection district of Anne Arundel county, to complete his collections.

The bill entitled, an act for the incorporation of Jefferson Lodge No. 9, of the order of Independent Odd Fellows.

The bill entitled, an act to confer additional powers upon the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore.

The bill entitled, an act to authorise the commissioners of Cecil county to issue summons or citations in certain cases.

The bill entitled, an act for the benefit of Philip Clayton, collector of taxes for the city of Annapolis ;

Severally endorsed "will pass."

The bill entitled, an act to elect the commissioners of tax of Carroll county by the people ;

Endorsed "will pass" with the proposed amendments .

Amendments proposed:

3rd section, 4th line, strike out 1843 and insert 1844.

9th section, 1st line, strike out 1844 and insert 1845.

9th section, 5th line, strike out 1845 and insert 1846.

10th section, strike out all after the word "held" in 8th line and insert "in the same manner and subject to the same regulations as are prescribed in the 6th section of this act, and the person having the highest number of votes in said county, and who shall reside in the commissioners district in which such vacancy may exist shall be declared to be duly elected."

11th section, strike out all after the word "enacted" and insert "that if any person to be elected under this act shall be found guilty of mal-practice or corruption in office, upon indictment and conviction in the county court of Carroll county, such person shall from the time of such conviction be disqualified from holding the office of commissioner of tax of Carroll county for the space of five years."

Add as an additional section :

"Section 15. And be it enacted, That it shall be the duty of the voters of Carroll county, at the next annual election for delegates to the General Assembly, to signify their approval of this act by endorsing on his ballots, either in writing or printing, the words "For electing commissioners" or "Against electing commissioners," as the case may be ; and it shall be the duty of the judges of election of said county, in counting said ballots, to keep a list of the ballots so cast, either for or against electing said commissioners ; and it shall be the duty of the return judges to transmit to the Governor of this State, a separate return of the ballots so cast, for and against electing said commissioners, and if it shall appear from the said return of the ballots so cast, that a majority of the whole number of voters of Carroll county, who shall vote for delegates to the General Assembly at said election, are in favor of electing said commissioners by the people, it shall be the duty
