Which were read and assented to, and the bill as amended, read the second time by special order, passed and sent to the Senate.

And also, as chairman of said committee, to which was referred the bill from the Senate entitled, an act to incorporate the trustees of the Rock Hall Chapel in Kent county, reported the same with the following amendments :

Amendments proposed.

Add the following as additional sections :

"Section 4th. And be it enacted, That nothing in this act shall be so construed as to authorize the said corporation to issue any note, token, device, scrip, or other evidence of debt to be used as currency."

"Section 5th. And be it enacted, That this act shall enure for thirty years, unless sooner repealed by the General Assembly."

Which were read and assented to, and the bill as amended read the second time by special order, passed and returned to the Senate.
