On motion of Mr. Buskirk,

Referred to the committee on Corporations.

Mr. Handy of Somerset reported a bill entitled, an act to make valid the official bond of James Polk, Register of Wills of Somerset county, and for other purposes;

Read the first, and by special order the second time, passed

and sent to the Senate.

On motion of Mr. Randall, The House took up the order submitted by him on the 2nd instant, to appoint a standing committee on printing;

And also, a bill entitled, an act to facilitate the settlement of the estate of Andrew Bruce, late of Allegany county, deceased;

The question being on the adoption of said order,

And on beingt put, it was adopted.
