

Read and referred to the committee on Colored Population.

Mr. Richardson presented the petition of the President and Directors of the Frederick County Bank, for an extension of their charter.

And the petition of the President and Directors of Fredericktown Savings Institution, asking an extension of their charter ;

Severally read and referred to the committee on Corporations.

On motion of Mr. Buskirk,

Leave was granted to Messrs. Buskirk, Neff, Pickell and Buchanan, to bring in a bill to incorporate the trustees of the Frostburg school in Allegany county.

On motion of Mr. Owens,

Ordered, That the committee on Ways and Means inquire into the propriety of extending the time now allowed by law for the collection of the direct and income taxes; and report to this House at as early a day as practicable.

On motion of Mr. Owens,

Ordered, That the committee on Claims take into consideration the propriety of providing for the more effectual ventilation of this Hall, and adopt such measures as to them may seem appropriate.

On motion of Mr. Gallagher,

Ordered, That Greenbury B. Wilson be and he is hereby appointed a director on the part of the State, in the Bank of Baltimore.

The rule being suspended,

Mr. Gallagher presented the petition of Mary Duvall, of the city of Baltimore, praying permission to bring into this State, from the State of Kentucky, a negro boy therein mentioned ;

Read and referred to the committee on Colored Population.

On motion of Mr. Harne,

Leave was granted to the committee of Grievances and Courts of Justice to bring in a bill to prevent the clerks of the county courts in this State, granting licenses to Jews as travelling hawkers and pedlars.

On motion of Mr. Roberts,

Leave was granted to Messrs. Roberts, Dunbracco and Clements, to bring in a bill entitled, a supplement to an act entitled, an act to establish magistrates' courts in the several counties in this State, and to prescribe their jurisdiction, passed December session 1835, chapter 201 ; so far as the same relates to Queen Ann's county.

On motion of Mr. Harne,

Leave was granted to the committee on Grievances and Courts of Justice, to bring in a bill to classify the business of Washington county court.

And to Messrs. Harne, Boteler, Weber and Nesbit, to bring in a bill directing the printing of the proceedings of the board of commissions of Washington county in two papers as being sufficient in all cases.
