Ordered, That the said resolution, as amended, be laid on the table.

Mr. Richardson submitted the following order:

Ordered, That the committee on Ways and Means inquire into he expediency of licensing all acting justices of the peace and constables, and report to this House by bill or otherwise;

Which was read.

On the question being put,

Will the House adopt the said order?

Determined in the negative.

On motion of Mr. Gallagher,

The House took up the bill entitled, an act to incorporate the German Washington Beneficial Society of Fell's Point and State of Maryland;

Read the second time by special order, passed and sent to the

Senate

The doorkeeper returned and reported that he had notified the absent members that their attendance was required in the House.

Mr. Rider reported a bill entitled, an act relating to out-door

pensioners in Somerset county.

Mr. Buchanan reported a bill entitled, an act supplementary to an act for the protection of mechanics and others in Allegany county, passed December session 1841, chapter 76;

Severally read the first time and laid on the table.

On motion of Mr. Thawley,

Leave was granted to the committee on Grievances and Courts of Justice to bring in a bill to stay executions in this State for twelve months.

On motion of Mr. Causin,

The House adjourned until Monday morning half past 9 o'clock.
