

The clerk of the Senate delivered the following:

A bill entitled, a supplement to the act passed at December session 1840, chapter 126 ;

Read the first time and referred to Messrs. Brown, Lecompte of Carroll, Powder and Shaw.

A bill entitled, an act to allow Samuel Miller, late collector of Cecil county, further time to complete his collections ;

Read the first time and referred to Messrs. Janney, Simpers, Lackland and Crookshanks.

A bill entitled, a supplement to the act passed at December session 1839, chapter 80 ;

Read the first time and referred to Messrs. Brown, Lecompte of Carroll, Shaw and Powder.

And a bill entitled, an act for the relief of Ann Campbell of Cecil county ;

Read the first time and referred to Messrs. Crookshanks, Janney, Simpers and Lackland.

Mr. Murray submitted the following resolution :

Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the judges of the orphans' courts of the State, when in the city of Annapolis, shall have the use of the State Library ;

Which was read, assented to and sent to the Senate.

Mr. Graves presented the report of the Commissioner of Loans in compliance with resolution No. 8, of 1840 ;

Read and referred to Messrs. Tuck and Roberts.

Mr. Brown, from the select committee to which was referred the bill from the Senate entitled, a supplement to the act passed at December session 1840, chapter 126, reported the same without amendment ;

Read the second time by special order, passed and returned to the Senate.

On motion of Mr. Key,

Ordered, That he be excused from serving as chairman of the committee on Colored Population.

The Speaker then announced the appointment of Mr. Weems on the said committee.

The House took up the order of the day, being the bill entitled, an act to repeal an act entitled an act to preserve the breed of fish in the waters of the Chesapeake bay, and for other purposes.

On motion of Mr. Sutton,

Ordered, That said bill be laid on the table.

Mr. Sutton then moved that the House do now adjourn ;

Determined in the negative.
