THAT SECTION 28 (I) OF ARTICLE 2B OF THE ANNOTATED CODE OF MARYLAND (1964 SUPPLEMENT), TITLE "ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES," SUBTITLE "LOCAL LICENSES AND LICENSE PROVISIONS," BE AND IT IS HEREBY REPEALED AND RE-ENACTED, WITH AMENDMENTS; AND THAT SECTION? OF CHAPTER 795 OF THE ACTS OF 1963 BE AND IT IS HEREBY REPEALED AND RE-ENACTED, WITH AMENDMENTS, BOTH TO READ AS FOLLOWS:

28.

- (H) THE BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS OF ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY MAY AUTHORIZE THE ISSUANCE OF LICENSES TO BE KNOWN AS "CABARET LICENSES" WITH-IN THE 1ST, 2ND, 3RD, 4TH, 5TH, 7TH, OR 8TH ELECTION DISTRICTS OF ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY. SUCH LICENSE SHALL PERMIT THE SALE OF ANY AND ALL ALCOHOLIC BEVERACES AT ONE OR MORE LOCATIONS WITHIN THE LICENSED PREMISES FOR THE CONSUMPTION OF SUCH ALCOHOLIC BEVERACES, EITHER ON OR OFF PREMISES, ON EVERY DAY OF THE WEEK INCLUDING SUNDAYS, BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 6:00 A.M. AND 5:00 A.M. OF THE DAY FOLLOWING EXCEPT AS PROHIBITED BY SECTION 88 OF THIS ARTICLE. IT SHALL BE LAWFUL TO SELL AND SERVE FOOD AND OTHER BEVERAGES, OPERATE AND FURNISH ANY LAWFUL ENTERTAINMENT OR AMUSEMENT, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO, DANC-ING, SINGING, MUSIC (LIVE OR RECORDED), FLOOR SHOWS, ACROBATIC ACTS, THEATRICALS, RADIO AND TELEVISION PROGRAMS, MOVING PICTURES, AMUSEMENT DEVICES, ETC., WITHIN THE LICENSED PREMISES. THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 28 (A), AND SECTIONS 116 AND 117 OF THIS ARTICLE SHALL NOT APPLY TO SUCH LICENSES, EXCEPT THAT NO PERSON UNDER THE AGE OF 21 YEARS SHALL BE EMPLOYED IN THE SALE OF ALCO-HOLIC BEVERAGES ON THE SAID LICENSED PREMISES. THE ANNUAL FEE FOR SUCH LICENSES SHALL BE FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$5,000). THE BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS OF ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY SHALL REQUIRE THAT THE LICENSED PREMISES CONTAIN ADE-QUATE AUTOMOBILE FACILITIES, AND THAT THE OPERA-TION OF SAID LICENSED PREMISES SHALL NOT CONSTI-TUTE A NUISANCE TO THE ENJOYMENT OF ADJACENT PROPERTIES AND SHALL OTHERWISE MEET WITH ALL THE REQUIREMENTS OF LAW RELATING TO THE SALE OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES.
- (i) (1) The number of premises for which licenses (including all classes or types of alcoholic beverage licenses which may be issued in any election precinct for the sale of alcoholic beverages at retail) may be issued in or transferred to a precinct of Anne Arundel County, EXCEPTING HOWEVER A TRANSFER FROM ONE LOCATION IN THE COUNTY TO ANOTHER LOCATION IN THE COUNTY OTHER THAN THE SIXTH ELECTION DISTRICT, OF THE SAME LICENSE OWNED BY THE PERSON OR CORPORATION SO TRANSFERRING is limited to one for each 1,000, or major fraction thereof, registered voters of the precinct in which the premises are located.
