

gomery County, annually, a certified copy of such detailed audit and financial statement.

(b) Said Commission is authorized to formulate and adopt a pension or retirement plan for its employees including the right to contract with any established insurance company or insurance companies for a group, annuity, retirement or pension plan, and to contribute so much thereto as it may deem equitable, or be required to pay under any contract, and such contribution or payment shall be charged as expenses of the several departments of the Commission in the same proportion that the receipts of the respective department bear to the total receipts of the Commission.

(c) The General Assembly of Maryland hereby finds, determines and declares that the term "Municipal Corporation" in Article 11E of the Constitution of Maryland does not embrace or include the Washington Suburban Sanitary District which was incorporated by Chapter 122 of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland of 1918, that the Washington Suburban Sanitary District cannot be classified in any group of Municipal Corporations as required by said Article 11E, and that said Article 11E theretofore has no application to the Washington Suburban Sanitary District.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That the terms of members of the Commission in office on the effective date of this Act shall not expire but shall be continued without interruption.

SEC. 3. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety, and having been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three-fifths of the members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, the same shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 173

(Senate Bill 570)

AN ACT relating to the Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission; to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Sections 59-2, 59-3, and 59-4 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Prince George's County (1963 Edition, being Article 17 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland), title "Prince George's County", sub-title "59. Park and Planning Commission"; these sections being also Sections 72-6, 72-7 and 72-8 of the Montgomery County Code, 1960 (being Article 16 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland), title "Montgomery County", sub-title "Chapter 72. Maryland National Capital Park and Planning Commission", sub-heading "Article I—In General"; to change the manner of appointing and confirming members of the Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission from Prince George's County, to continue the terms of such members of the Commission in office on the effective date of this Act, to change the manner
