CHAPTER 459
(House Bill 1198)

AN ACT to repeal Sections 46-1 and 46-2 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Prince George's County (1963 Edition, being Article 17 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland), title "Prince George's ~~County~~ COUNTY," subtitle "Jurors," amending the law concerning the selection of jurors and methods of drawing the same in Prince George's County.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Sections 46-1 and 46-2 of the Code of Public Laws of Prince George's County (1963 Edition) title "Prince George's County," subtitle "Jurors" be and they are hereby repealed.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1965.

CHAPTER 460
(Senate Bill 15)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 30(1) of Article 48A of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1964 Replacement Volume), title "Insurance Code," subtitle "2. Insurance Department and Insurance Commissioner," to change the required frequency of examination of domestic insurers under the Insurance Code.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Section 30(1) of Article 48A of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1964 Replacement Volume), title "Insurance Code," subtitle "2. Insurance Department and Insurance Commissioner," be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:
