Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Sections 13 and 14 of Article 7 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Carroll County", sub-title "Billiards", as said sections were last amended by Chapter 880 of the Acts of 1943, be and they are hereby repealed.
- SEC. 2. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1965.
