consist of Caroline, Cecil, Dorchester, Kent, Queen Anne's, Talbot, Somerset, Wicomico and Worcester counties; two members who shall reside on the Western Shore, which shall consist of Harford, Baltimore, Anne Arundel, and Prince George's counties and Baltimore City; and one member who shall reside in either Calvert, Charles or St. Mary's counties. Those members serving on the Commission of Tidewater Fisheries on June 1, [1964] 1965, shall continue in office until the expiration of their terms of office and shall continue to receive the compensation provided immediately prior to June 1, 1964. Members of the Commission shall be eligible for reappointment. Vacancies on the Commission shall be filled for the remainder of the unexpired term by the Governor.

(b) Each member of the Commission, including the chairman, shall receive such remuneration as may be provided in the annual State budget [for attending the monthly meetings of the Commission and for attending, when requested by the chairman, at other meetings and hearings of the Commission]. Members shall also be reimbursed for actual expenses incurred in attending to the business of the Commission, within budgetary limitations.

- (f) To [approve programs of the Department as represented in the annual budget] review the annual budget request of the Department and to approve or disapprove any items reflecting changes in established programs or objectives before October 1 of each year.
- SEC. 2. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1965.

CHAPTER 612

(Senate Bill 454)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 103D of Article 41 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1964 Supplement), title "Governor—Executive and Administrative Departments—Charitable Organizations", extending the exemption from this sub-title to all charitable organizations which are members of a Community Chest or United Fund duly incorporated under the laws of the State of Maryland.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Section 103D of Article 41 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1964 Supplement), title "Governor—Executive and Administrative Departments—Charitable Organizations", be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

103D. Every charitable organization subject to the provisions of this sub-title shall keep a full and true record in such form as will enable such charitable organization accurately to provide the infor-
