CHAPTER 85

(Senate Bill 144)

AN ACT to repeal Sections 1, 2, 3, 7 and 8 of Article 19 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "St. Mary's County", sub-title "Almshouse", Section 2 thereof having been amended by Chapter 249 of the Acts of 1951, repealing certain unnecessary and obsolete local laws of St. Mary's County concerning the management and operation of a County almshouse.

**SECTION 1.** *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Sections 1, 2, 3, 7 and 8 of Article 19 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "St. Mary's County", sub-title "Almshouse", Section 2 thereof having been amended by Chapter 249 of the Acts of 1951, be and they are hereby repealed.

**SEC. 2.** *And be it further enacted,* That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1965.

CHAPTER 86

(Senate Bill 145)

AN ACT to repeal Section 92 of Article 19 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "St. Mary's County", sub-title "Landlord and Tenant", repealing a duplicating local law of St. Mary's County concerning landlords and tenants and the reservation of rent and advances.
