CHAPTER 681

(Senate Bill 598)

AN ACT to add new Section 119 (n) to Article 52 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1964 Replacement Volume), title "Justices of the Peace", sub-title "Trial Magistrates System", to follow immediately after Section 119 (m) thereof, raising the salary for the substitute trial magistrate in Dorchester County.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That new Section 119 (n) be and it is hereby added to Article 52 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1964 Replacement Volume), title "Justices of the Peace", sub-title "Trial Magistrates System", to follow immediately after Section 119 (m) thereof, and to read as follows:

119.

(n) *In Dorchester County, the substitute trial magistrate shall receive a salary of seven hundred and fifty dollars (\$750.00) per year.*

CHAPTER 682

(Senate Bill 612)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 97B (a) of Article 52 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1964 Replacement Volume), title "Justices of the Peace", sub-title "Trial Magistrates System"; to provide for the salary of committing magistrates in Charles County.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Section 97B (a) of Article 52 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1964 Replacement Volume), title "Justices of the Peace", sub-title "Trial Magistrates System", be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:
