- (d) The Third Legislative District is composed of Election Districts 4, 5, 6, 7 and 8; and Precincts 1 through 9, inclusive, and 17 through 21, inclusive, of Election District 9; and of Election District 10; and shall elect 3 Delegates.
- (e) The Fourth Legislative District is composed of Precincts 10 through 16, inclusive, and 22 through 54, inclusive, of Election District 9; and shall elect 3 Delegates.
- (f) The Fifth Legislative District is composed of Election District 14 and of Precincts 1 through 5, inclusive, 8, 9, 23, and 29 through 36, inclusive, of Election District 15; and shall elect 3 Delegates.
- (g) The Sixth Legislative District is composed of Election District 11; and of Precincts 6, 7, 10 through 22, inclusive, and 24 through 28, inclusive, of Election District 15; and shall elect 4 Delegates.
- (h) The Seventh Legislative District is composed of Election District 12; and shall elect 3 Delegates.
- (i) This section shall apply to every primary and general election held after the effective date of this Act, and to that end all laws or parts of laws, public general or public local, inconsistent with the provisions of this section are hereby repealed to the extent of the inconsistency; and this section, being in furtherance of requirements of the Constitution of the United States, prevails to the extent of any inconsistency over Section 2, 5, 6, 9, and 13 of Article III of the Constitution of Maryland; provided, however, that this section shall be of no force or effect while any act of the General Assembly or any amendment to the Constitution of Maryland subsequent to the effective date of this Act, is in effect which allots to Baltimore County a number of Senators other than seven or a number of Delegates other than twenty-two.
- Sec. 2. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1966."
