election of the House of Delegates of Maryland and to the representation of the several political subdivisions therein.

Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Rules.

House Bill No. 4—By the Speaker:

AN ACT making an emergency appropriation for the payment of the expenses of the General Assembly of Maryland for the Extraordinary Session of 1965.

Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Rules.

House Bill No. 5—By the Prince George's County Delegation:

AN ACT to add new Sections 21-2 to 21-5 inclusive to the Code of Public Local Laws of Prince George's County (1963 Edition), being Article 17 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, to be in the subtitle "Crimes and Punishments," to follow immediately after Section 21-1 thereof, and to be under the new subheading "Real Estate Practices," providing that in Prince George's County certain practices and acts are prohibited in connection with the sale, lease, or other transfer of real estate, and relating generally to the sale, lease, or other transfer of real estate in Prince George's County.

Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Rules.

House Bill No. 6—By Delegate Bresler:

AN ACT to add a new Section 42A to Article 40 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1957 Edition and 1964 Supplement), title "General Assembly," subtitle "Apportionment," to follow immediately after Section 42 thereof, revising the laws now providing for the apportionment of representation in the Senate of Maryland; providing for the apportionment, members, and elections for members of the Senate and for the districts which are to be the basis of representation in each of the two Houses; imposing certain duties upon the Governor of Maryland in relation to such apportionment, representation, and districts; providing for the effect of this Act on certain sections in Article 3 of the Constitution of Maryland; providing for contingencies whereby part or all of this Act becomes no longer effective, and relating generally to the apportionment and representation in the Senate of Maryland, to the election of members thereof, and to the duties of certain State officers in relation thereto.

Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Rules.

House Bill No. 7—By the Prince George's County Delegation:

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 108(16) (a) of Article 52 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1963-1964 Replacement Volume), title "Justices of the Peace," subtitle "Trial Magistrates System," to increase the salary of the judges of the People's Court of Prince George's County.
