## INTRODUCTION OF BILL

House Bill No. 17—By Delegate McGuirk:

AN ACT to add new Section 17A to Article 78 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1957 Edition), title "Public Service Commission Law," subtitle "Public Service Commission," subheading "Personnel of Commission in General," to follow immediately after Section 17 thereof, to provide that the Executive Secretary of the Public Service Commission shall until a specified time be deemed an appointed official of the State of Maryland for all purposes of the State employees' retirement system laws which provide a mandatory age for retirement, and providing for the automatic expiration of this Act.
