WHEREAS, the softball team sponsored by Bucky Helm and playing as Bucky's Team advanced through the preliminary rounds to become the finalists in the State Softball Championships; and

Whereas, the House wishes to commend Bucky's for their sportsmanship and for the athletic prowess it has displayed in bringing the Softball Championship to South Baltimore; and

Whereas, the winning of this Championship by Bucky's further emphasizes the urgent need for installation of lights at Riverside Park so that softball can be played and teams can practice at night; now, therefore, be it

Resolved by the House of Delegates of Maryland, That we extend heartiest congratulations to Bucky's Softball Team of South Baltimore upon winning the State Softball Championship; and be it further

Resolved, That copies of this Resolution are sent to the Manager of Bucky's, George Freeberger, and to its sponsor, Bucky Helm.

INTRODUCTION OF BILL

House Bill No. 20—By Delegates Resnick and Hardwicke:

AN ACT to add a new Section 42A to Article 40 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1957 Edition and 1964 Supplement), title "General Assembly," subtitle "Apportionment," to follow immediately after Section 42 thereof, and to be under the new subheading "Senate," revising the laws now providing for the apportionment of representation in the Senate of Maryland; providing for the apportionment, members, and elections for members of the Senate and for the districts which are to be the basis of representation in the Senate; providing for the effect of this Act on certain sections in Article 3 of the Constitution of Maryland; and relating generally to the apportionment and representation in the Senate of Maryland, to the election of members thereof.

Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Rules.
