

"Sec. 4. And be it further enacted, That in the event the provisions of Section 42E (a-1) of this Act shall be declared valid by the Court of Appeals of Maryland, then the provisions of Section 42E (a) of this Act shall not become effective. The Attorney General of Maryland is hereby directed to promptly request a judicial determination of this Act by the appropriate legal procedure."

Amendment No. 5—In line 1 of Section 4 on page 8 of the third reading file bill, strike out the numeral "4" and insert in lieu thereof the numeral "5"; and in the same line after the word "That" add the following: ", subject to the provisions of Section 4 above,"
