

SAND DOLLARS (\$31,125,000), the proceeds thereof to be used for certain necessary building, construction, planning, deferred maintenance and equipment purposes of this State, for acquiring certain land and options in connection therewith, and for razing certain State-owned buildings, and providing generally for the issue and sale of Certificates of Indebtedness evidencing such loan, and, for the purposes of this Act, modifying the provisions of Section 8 of Chapter 159 of the Acts of 1964.

EXECUTIVE'S MESSAGE

Dear Mr. President:

I hereby approve Senate Bill 2 except for the following enumerated items which I hereby expressly disapprove and veto in accordance with the power and authority conferred upon me by Article II, Section 17 of the Constitution of Maryland:

1. Section 5 (C) (7) relating to an appropriation of \$25,000 for the State's share of the cost for preliminary planning for campus development contingent upon matching funds being made available from the Montgomery County University Foundation; and

Shall Item No. 1 pass notwithstanding the objections of the Executive?
