SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Sections 260, 261, 263, 264, 265, 265A, 265B, 265C, 265D, 265E, 267, 268, 268A, 268B, 272, 280, 281 and 282 (a) and (e) of Article 77 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1965 Replacement Volume), title "Public Education," subtitle "Chapter 27. Free Scholarships," be and they are hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

260.

There is hereby established a program of State Scholarships for students enrolled in St. Mary's College of Maryland.

Beginning for the academic year 1966-67 and thereafter, one student from each COUNTY AND EACH senatorial district of [the State] Baltimore City, and each county, appointed according to the provisions of Section 282 of this article, shall be educated by the College free of charge for tuition, room and board.

261.

There is hereby established a program of State scholarships for students enrolled in St. John's College of Annapolis.

Beginning for the academic year 1967-68 and thereafter, one student from each COUNTY AND EACH senatorial district of [the State] Baltimore City, and each county, appointed according to the provisions of Section 282 of this article, shall be educated by the College free of charge for tuition.

263.

There is hereby established a program of State scholarships for students enrolled in Hood College of Frederick.

- (a) Beginning for the academic year 1966-67 and thereafter, one student from each COUNTY AND EACH senatorial district of the State Baltimore City, and each county, appointed according to the provisions of Section 282 of this article, shall be educated by the College free of charge for tuition, room and board. Each student accepting such an appointment shall pursue a course of study at the College leading to a regular teacher's certificate in the public school system of Maryland, and shall give bond to the State of Maryland, according to the provisions of Section 284B of this article, that she will teach in the public schools of the State for not less than two years.
- (b) Beginning for the academic year 1967-68 and thereafter, one student from each COUNTY AND EACH senatorial district of [the State] Baltimore City, and each county, appointed according to the provisions of Section 282 of this article, and beginning for the academic year 1968-69 and thereafter, one additional student from each COUNTY AND EACH senatorial district of [the State] Baltimore City, and each county, appointed according to Section 282 of this article, shall be educated by the College free of charge for tuition.
