

CHAPTER 674

(House Bill 581)

AN ACT to add new Section 657A to Article 43 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1965 Replacement Volume), title "Health," subtitle "Sanitary Districts," to follow immediately after Section 657 thereof, to provide for an exemption in Somerset County of the property of any incorporated American Legion Post from the levy of any taxes, charges or assessments of whatever kind against the property by the Somerset County Sanitary District.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* The new Section 657A be and it is hereby added to Article 43 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1965 Replacement Volume), title "Health," subtitle "Sanitary Districts," to follow immediately after Section 657 thereof, and to read as follows:

657A.

Notwithstanding any requirements of this subtitle to the contrary, in Somerset County, any incorporated American Legion Post is exempted from payment of any taxes, charges or assessments of whatever kind levied against the property of any such Post by the Somerset County Sanitary District, Inc. under the provisions of this subtitle.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted,* That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1966.

CHAPTER 675

(House Bill 31)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 546 of Article 43 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1965 Replacement Volume), title "Health," subtitle "Cosmetologists," amending certain laws relating to the State Board of Cosmetologists in order to correct an error therein.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Section 546 of Article 43 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1965 Replacement Volume), title "Health," subtitle "Cosmetologists," be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

546.

Any investigation, inquiry or hearing or examination which said Board is empowered by law to hold or undertake may be held or undertaken by or before any two members of said Board or its secretary, and the finding or order of such members of said Board or such representative, when concurred in by two members of the Board, shall have the same [form] force and effect as the finding or order of the whole Board and shall be so considered.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted,* That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1966.
