limited to investment of county moneys and purchase and issue of bonds; and to submit at least monthly to the County Commissioners a complete financial statement showing the assets, liabilities, and financial condition of the county.

- (13) To control and supervise all county expenditures on the basis of authorized budget allotments and to report monthly thereon to the several offices, departments, boards, commissions, and other agencies of the county government.
- (14) To examine, audit, and approve all bills, demands, or charges against the county and to determine their regularity, legality, and correctness.
- (15) To supervise and manage for the county, the purchase of materials, goods, and services, following accepted and proper purchasing procedures.
- (16) To perform such other duties and functions as may be assigned to him from time to time by the Board of County Commissioners.
- (d) In the temporary absence of the County Administrator, the Board of County Commissioners may appoint an Acting County Administrator. During the period of holding this position, the Acting County Administrator has all the powers, duties, functions, and responsibilities of the office of the County Administrator.
- SEC. 2. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect January 1, 1967.

CHAPTER 749

(House Bill 1033)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, SECTION 168 (A) AND Section 168(d) of Article 48A of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1964 Replacement Volume), title "Insurance," subtitle "11. Agents and Brokers," to provide for the licensing of partnerships and corporations as agents or brokers; to provide for the filing of broker's bonds by partnership or corporation insurance agencies; and to require that individual agents and brokers of partnership or corporation insurance agencies be individually qualified and licensed for the kinds of insurance business the individual does with the public; and providing that this Act be effective November 1, 1966.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Section 168(d) of Article 48A of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1964 Replacement Volume), title "Insurance," subtitle "11. Agents and Brokers," be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:
