(Senate Joint Resolution 41)

Senate Joint Resolution requesting the ~~Governor~~ WASHINGTON COUNTY DELEGATION IN THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND AND THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF WASHINGTON COUNTY to appoint a lower court evaluation commission for Washington County.

WHEREAS, the trial magistrate system now existing in Washington County is a most important part of the judicial process in that county as in other portions of the State.

Many citizens have their only contact with judicial processes in cases that are brought before the trial magistrates' courts.

As the population of Washington County increases and as additional laws are enacted, the responsibility and the workload of the trial magistrates' courts naturally increase.

For these reasons, it is vital that a comprehensive evaluation be made of the functions and activities of the trial magistrates' courts in Washington County.

This study could include consideration of possibly changing the form and functions of the present courts including the possibility of creating a new lower court system of the people's court type in Washington County; now, therefore, be it
