*Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Governor of Maryland is BE requested to appoint a Commission of not more than ten persons, including persons competent and knowledgeable in planning and zoning controls and laws, to make a comprehensive review of the State's planning and zoning laws, for the purpose of preparing a revision of these laws, and to report its recommendations to the General Assembly and the Legislative Council for the 1967 Session of the General Assembly, and be it further*
