contingent expenses, fuel and other items, and stating the purposes for which said expenses are applied; and in the account of fees there shall be a separate statement of all those fees charged during the year included in said account, which at the date of said account remained uncollected.

[36. The clerk of any court shall, upon application during the vacation of said court, enter an appeal from the judgment, order or decree of said court to the Court of Appeals.]

## Clerk of Court of Special Appeals

- 46A. There shall be a Clerk of the Court of Special Appeals who shall be appointed by and shall hold his office at the pleasure of said Court. He shall receive such compensation as shall be provided in the annual State budget. The said Clerk shall have the custody of all the records and papers of the Court of Special Appeals. He may appoint, subject to the approval of the Judges of the Court of Special Appeals, such Deputy Clerks and other employees as the requirements of his office as Clerk of the Court of Special Appeals shall necessitate, who shall perform such duties as shall be prescribed by the said Judges and the Clerk, and shall receive such compensation as shall be provided in the annual State budget. The Clerk of the Court of Special Appeals shall provide such record books, dockets, etc., as may be suitable and necessary, and shall give certified copies under the seal of said Court of all papers and records of which he shall have custody as aforesaid and such copies shall be evidenced in the same manner as other certified copies of record are.
- 46B. The Clerk of the Court of Special Appeals, before he acts as such, shall give bond to the State of Maryland in such penal sum as the State Comptroller may prescribe, with security or securities to be approved by a judge of the Court of Special Appeals, and with condition that he faithfully perform the duties of his office and account for all funds received under color of his office. He shall give a new bond in like manner on or before the first day of December of each second year following his qualification in office. Such bonds shall be filed with the State Comptroller.
- The Director of the Administrative Office of the Courts under the direction and supervision of the Court of Special Appeals shall arrange for the publication of the opinions of the Court of Special Appeals and let the necessary contracts for the same. He shall secure the copyright of the published opinions for the State of Maryland and as its property. The cost of advertising for proposals for the publication of said reports shall be paid by the Comptroller upon the presentation of properly authenticated vouchers. Contracts may be awarded upon such terms and conditions as the Director, under the direction and supervision of the Court of Special Appeals, shall deem necessary. Upon establishing a contract with a publisher, the said Director shall promptly deliver to the said publisher accurate typewritten copies of all the opinions of the Court of Special Appeals, to be paid for from funds provided in the Judiciary budget. The publisher then shall deliver to the State Library three hundred copies of each volume bound in a first-class manner; and the State shall pay therefor to the publisher the contract price per volume for each of said three hundred volumes.
- SEC. 3. And be it further enacted, That Sections 1 (a), 23, 24, 27 and 49 of Article 26 of the said Code (1957 Edition and 1965 Sup-
