CHAPTER 139 (Senate Bill 33)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 657 of Article 43 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1965 Replacement Volume), title "Health", subtitle "Sanitary Districts", correcting an error in the laws relating to certain Sanitary Districts and to charges for connections and the assessments of benefits thereunder; and creating subsections in this Section 657.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Section 657 of Article 43 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1965 Replacement Volume), title "Health", subtitle "Sanitary Districts", be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, and to read as follows:

657.

(a) For the purpose of paying the interest and principal of the bonds issued in the name of a district by any said commission as in this subtitle provided for the water or sewerage systems to be constructed, purchased or established under this subtitle, the said commission is hereby empowered to establish a proper and reasonable charge, payable to such district, not less than the actual cost thereof, for connection with said water and sewerage system so to be constructed, purchased or established as aforesaid, and to fix an annual assessment, payable to such district on all properties, improved or unimproved, binding upon a street, road, lane, alley or right of way in which a water main or sewer has been built. The said annual assessment shall be made upon the front-foot basis, and the first payment shall be collected during the year in which the construction is completed on the water or sewerage systems, or in which the systems are purchased or acquired.
