

YEARS, AND UNTIL THEIR SUCCESSORS SHALL BE ELECTED AND QUALIFIED. EACH OF SAID COMMISSIONERS SHALL RECEIVE AN ANNUAL SALARY OF \$1,500.00 IN ADDITION TO THE MILEAGE WHICH MAY BE ALLOWED BY LAW.

SEC. 7. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, THAT SECTION 292 OF SAID CODE, BEING SAID ARTICLE OF SAID CODE OF PUBLIC LOCAL LAWS, SAID TITLE, SUBTITLE "REVENUE AND TAXES," BE AND IT IS HEREBY REPEALED AND RE-ENACTED, WITH AMENDMENTS, TO READ AS FOLLOWS:

THE TREASURER SHALL APPOINT A DEPUTY, WHO SHALL PERFORM SUCH DUTIES AS THE SAID TREASURER MAY REQUIRE, AND FOR WHOSE OFFICIAL CONDUCT SAID TREASURER SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE, AND WHO SHALL ACT FOR SAID TREASURER DURING THE TREASURER'S ABSENCE; THE SALARY OF THE SAID DEPUTY SHALL BE \$4,250.00 ANNUALLY AND SHALL BE PAID ON A MONTHLY BASIS.

SEC. 8. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, THAT SECTION 301 OF SAID CODE, BEING SAID ARTICLE OF SAID CODE OF PUBLIC LOCAL LAWS, SAID TITLE, SUBTITLE "ROADS," BE AND IT IS HEREBY REPEALED AND RE-ENACTED, WITH AMENDMENTS, TO READ AS FOLLOWS:

301.

THE MEMBERS OF THE COUNTY ROADS BOARD FOR SOMERSET COUNTY SHALL EACH RECEIVE, IN ADDITION TO THEIR COMPENSATION AS COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, A SALARY OF FIFTEEN HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$1,500) ANNUALLY AS A MEMBER OF THE COUNTY ROADS BOARD; AND IN CONSIDERATION OF THE ADDITIONAL SERVICES TO BE PERFORMED BY HIM UNDER THIS SUBHEADING, THE COUNTY TREASURER OF SOMERSET COUNTY SHALL RECEIVE A SALARY OF SIX HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$600.00) ANNUALLY; AND THE COUNTY ROADS BOARD WILL MEET CONCURRENTLY WITH THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF SOMERSET COUNTY AND ON THE FOURTH FRIDAY OF EACH MONTH, AND AS OFTEN THEREAFTER AS THE COUNTY ROADS BOARD MAY DEEM NECESSARY FOR THE PROPER PERFORMANCE OF THEIR DUTIES.

SEC. 9. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, THAT THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ACT SHALL NOT BE CONSTRUED TO EXTEND OR TO APPLY TO ANY ELECTED OFFICIAL IN OFFICE ON THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS ACT, BUT THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ACT SHALL TAKE EFFECT WITH THE NEXT TERM OF OFFICE.

SEC. 10. *And be it further enacted,* That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1966.
