SEC. 6. *And be it further enacted,* That all unexpended funds remaining from completed projects authorized under this Act shall be transferred to the Annuity Bond Fund and shall be applied to the debt service requirements of the State, said transfer to be made one year after the date of the final acceptance of the project by the State, said date of final acceptance to be certified in writing to the Board of Public Works by the Department of Public Improvements.

SEC. 7. *And be it further enacted,* That any furniture, fixtures and/or equipment authorized to be paid for from the sales of the Certificates of Indebtedness authorized by this Act shall be, where possible, manufactured or produced by the State Use Industries operated by the Department of Correction, in accordance with the provisions of Section 680 of Article 27, Annotated Code of Maryland (1965 Supplement).

SEC. 8. *And be it further enacted,* That, except as otherwise provided in this Act, no department, board, commission, agency or institution specified or named in this Act shall begin any work with funds secured pursuant to the provisions of this Act unless satisfactory assurances are made to the Board of Public Works that the work described in the individual terms in this Act can be completed with the Funds specified for each such item respectively.

SEC. 9. *And be it further enacted,* That if any Federal grant is or becomes available to any of the State Colleges, the University of Maryland, Morgan State College, St. Mary's College of Maryland, the Department of Mental Hygiene, or the Department of Forests and Parks for capital improvements, which grant is to pay a portion of the cost of such improvements as set out in this Act for any of these institutions or departments, then the State appropriation herein provided for any such capital improvements in each instance shall be reduced by an amount equal to the amount of the Federal grant.
