Amendment No. 1—Strike out all of lines 1-5, inclusive, 1-4, inclusive, 1-4, inclusive, 1-5, inclusive, 1-3, inclusive, 1-5, inclusive, 1-5, inclusive, and 1-3, inclusive, comprising all of Section 166C, 166D, 166E, 166F, 166G, 166H, 166-I, and 166J, on pages 1 and 2 of the printed bill, and insert in lieu thereof the following:

"166C.

The First Congressional District is composed of the counties of Caroline, Cecil, Dorchester, Harford, Kent, Queen Anne's, Somerset, Talbot, Wicomico and Worcester and those portions of Baltimore County within the boundaries of election districts 6, 7, and 10.

166D.

The Second Congressional District is composed of all of Baltimore County except those portions of Baltimore County within the boundaries of election districts 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, and 10.

166E.

The Third Congressional District is composed of those portions of Baltimore City within wards 1, 2, and 8 and precincts 12 through 19, inclusive, of ward 25, ward 26, except precincts 35 to 45, inclusive, wards 22, 23 and 24, and Anne Arundel County.

166F.

The Fourth Congressional District is composed of those portions of Baltimore City within wards 3 through 7, inclusive; 9 through 12, inclusive; 17, 18, and 19 and precincts 1 through 81, inclusive, of ward 27, and precincts 35 through 45, inclusive, of ward 26.

166G.

The Fifth Congressional District is composed of the counties of Prince George's, Charles, Calvert, and St. Mary's.

166H.

The Sixth Congressional District is composed of the counties of Allegany, Carroll, Frederick, Garrett, and Washington and those portions of Baltimore County within the boundaries of election districts 4, 5, and 8.

166-I.

The Seventh Congressional District is composed of those portions of Baltimore City within wards 13, 14, 15, 16, 20, and 21 and precincts 1 through 11, inclusive, of ward 25, precincts 82 through 105, inclusive, of ward 27 and ward 28.

166J.

The Eighth Congressional District is composed of the counties of Montgomery and Howard."
