INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

Senate Bill No. 1—By the President :

AN ACT to add a new Section 323A to Article 81 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1965 Replacement Volume), title "Revenue and Taxes," subtitle "Income Tax," to follow immediately after Section 323 thereof, providing that the County Council or Board of County Commissioners of any county and the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore for a stated period may levy and impose a local tax on income; providing generally for the rate, levy, imposition, collection, and distribution of this tax, and relating generally to the levy, imposition, and collection of a local tax on income by any of the respective counties or City of Baltimore.

Senate Bill No. 2—By the President :

AN ACT making an emergency appropriation for the payment of the expenses of the General Assembly of Maryland for the Extraordinary Session of 1966.
