INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

Senate Bill No. 15—By Senator Parran:

AN ACT to add new Section 411V to Article 66C of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1965 Supplement), title "Natural Resources," subtitle "Patuxent River Watershed," to follow immediately after Section 411U thereof, to create a Patuxent River Commission for the purpose of preparing a comprehensive plan for the use of land and water in the Patuxent River Basin, to provide for the composition and qualifications of the members of the Commission and for their compensation, powers and duties.

Read the first time and referred to the Rules Committee.

Senate Bill No. 16—By Senator Snyder:

AN ACT to add new Section 46 to Article 40 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1965 Replacement Volume), title "General Assembly," to follow immediately after Section 45 thereof, and to be under the new subtitle "Sub-Districts for the Senate," providing for the boundaries of senatorial sub-districts in Senatorial District No. 1 comprising Garrett, Allegany and Washington Counties.

Read the first time and referred to the Rules Committee.

Senate Bill No. 17—By Senators Hall, Derr, Hughes, Graham, Gude, Steffey and Phoebus:

AN ACT to repeal Section 42 of Article 27 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1957 Edition), title "Crimes and Punishments," subtitle "Contracts with Public Institutions," and to repeal Article 19A of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1957 Edition, 1965 Supplement),
