

Amendment No. 2—In lines 9 and 10 of the title of the printed bill, strike out the following: “any of the respective counties or” and insert in lieu thereof the following: “the.”

Amendment No. 3—In lines 2 and 3 of Section 323A on page 1 of the printed bill, strike out the following: “County Council or Board of County Commissioners of any county and the.”

Amendment No. 4—In line 6 of Section 323A on page 1 of the printed bill, strike out the following: “the respective” and insert in lieu thereof the word “this.”
