

(b) The value of an award when used at any institution listed in Category II is five hundred dollars (\$500.00).

(c) The value of an award when used at any institution listed in Category III is two hundred and fifty dollars (\$250.00).

(a) For the scholastic year beginning in 1967,

(1) Each Senator may make one award in alphabetical order to each of the first six institutions alphabetically listed in Category I of Section 261 of this Article; and may make one award in alphabetical order to each of the first five institutions alphabetically listed in Category II, and in addition may make four awards to any institution under Category III; and

(2) The State Scholarship Board may make one award in alphabetical order to each of the first five institutions in an alphabetical combination of Category I and Category II for each county of the State and each legislative district of Baltimore City.

(b) For the scholastic year beginning in 1968,

(1) Each Senator may make one award in alphabetical order to each of the second six institutions alphabetically listed in Category I; and may make one award in alphabetical order to each of the second four institutions alphabetically listed in Category II, and in addition may make four awards to any institution under Category III; and

(2) The State Scholarship Board may make one award in alphabetical order to each of the second five institutions in an alphabetical combination of Category I and Category II for each county of the State and each legislative district of Baltimore City.

(c) For the scholastic year beginning in 1969,

(1) Each Senator may make one award in alphabetical order to each of the first six institutions alphabetically listed in Category I; and may make one award in alphabetical order to each of the first five institutions alphabetically listed in Category II; and in addition may make four awards to any institution under Category III above; and

(2) The State Scholarship Board may make one award in alphabetical order to each of the third five institutions in an alphabetical combination of Category I and Category II for each county and each legislative district of Baltimore City.

(d) For the scholastic year beginning in 1970,

(1) Each Senator may make one award in alphabetical order to each of the second six institutions alphabetically listed in Category I; and may make one award in alphabetical order to each of the second four institutions alphabetically listed in Category II; and in addition may make four awards to any institution under Category III above; and

(2) The State Scholarship Board may make one award in alphabetical order to each of the remaining six institutions in an alphabetical combination of Category I and Category II for each county and each legislative district of Baltimore City.
