CHAPTER 119

(House Bill 85)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 37(s) of Article 87, of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1966 Cumulative Supplement), title "Sheriffs," subtitle "Compensation and Duties," correcting an error therein dealing with the Sheriff's office of Somerset County.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Section 37(s) of Article 87, of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1966 Cumulative Supplement), title "Sheriffs," subtitle "Compensation and Duties," be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

37.

(s)(1) The Sheriff of Somerset County shall receive an annual salary of four thousand two hundred dollars (\$4,200.00), and an annual allowance of one thousand two hundred dollars (\$1,200.00) for expenses. He shall appoint not less than two deputies, one of whom shall be known as the chief deputy and shall receive an annual salary of three thousand dollars (\$3,000.00), the second deputy shall receive an annual salary of two thousand seven hundred dollars (\$2,700.00). The Sheriff may appoint such additional deputies [as] at such compensation as may be approved by the County Commissioners. The Sheriff or one of his deputies shall act as county jailer and for that responsibility shall receive annual compensation, in addition to his regular salary, in the amount of fifteen hundred dollars (\$1,500.00). The Sheriff shall appoint a jail matron at an annual salary of six hundred dollars (\$600.00).

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1967.
