

~~[(c-3) Same—Maximum supplementation to be provided by political subdivision.—A political subdivision shall not provide supplementation in such an amount that the salary specified in subsection (b) plus the amount of the supplementation would exceed in the aggregate the sum of twenty-three thousand dollars (\$23,000.) per annum.]~~

~~[(c-4) Same—Certain counties.—Notwithstanding any other provisions of this section:~~

~~(A) The County Commissioners of Prince George's County are authorized to pay from any amounts received from the State Comptroller under the provisions of subsection (c-1) hereof or elsewhere, in addition to the sums provided by Section 282A of the Code of Public Local Laws of Prince George's County, an amount not to exceed three thousand dollars (\$3,000), per annum to each of the judges of the circuit court of the seventh judicial circuit of Maryland who resides in Prince George's County, and an amount not to exceed one thousand seven hundred fifty dollars (\$1,750) per annum to each of the judges of the seventh judicial circuit who is a non-resident of Prince George's County and who sits in the Circuit Court for Prince George's County at the request of the resident judges of Prince George's County.~~

~~(B) The County Council of Montgomery County is authorized to pay from any amounts received from the State Comptroller under the provisions of subsection (c-1) hereof, in addition to the sums provided by Section 7-16 of the Montgomery County Code, 1960, an amount not to exceed three thousand dollars (\$3,000) per annum to each of the judges of the circuit court of the sixth judicial circuit who resides in Montgomery County; and said County Council may provide additional supplementation of the salaries of each of said judges in such amount as the County Council may determine.~~

~~(C) The County Commissioners of Frederick County are directed to pay from any amounts received from the State Comptroller under the provisions of this subsection (c-1), in addition to the sums provided by Section 5-8 of the Frederick County Code, 1959, an amount not to exceed two thousand five hundred dollars (\$2,500.00) per annum to each of the judges of the circuit court of the sixth judicial circuit who reside in Frederick County, and who were serving in such positions prior to January 1, 1964.~~

~~(D) In Baltimore County, the County Council may provide supplementation for the salaries of the judges of the third judicial circuit who are resident in Baltimore County in such amount as the County Council may determine.]~~

~~(d) Salaries payable monthly.—All salaries herein provided for shall be payable monthly. BI-WEEKLY.~~

48. Additional salaries for judges of Circuit Court for Washington County.

~~[(Notwithstanding any other provision of this subtitle and in addition to any other annual salary, payment, or supplementation thereof, the County Commissioners of Washington County are hereby authorized and directed to pay to each of the several judges of the Circuit Court for Washington County two thousand five hundred dollars (\$2,500.00) annually.]~~
