I, LLOYD L. SIMPKINS, SECRETARY OF STATE OF THE STATE OF MARYLAND, pursuant to the direction contained in Section 172(c) of Article 33 of the Annotated Code of Maryland, (1957 Edition), Do HEREBY CERTIFY, that at the General Election held in the State of Maryland on November 8, 1966, an Act known as Chapter 428 of the Acts of 1966, was submitted to the voters of the State of Maryland, pursuant to the provisions of Article 14 of the Constitution of the State of Maryland, said Act being as follows:

AN ACT to propose an amendment to Section 1 of Article VI of the Constitution of Maryland, title "Treasury Department," to provide that the salary of the State Treasurer is fixed by the General Assembly by law, and providing for the submission of this amendment to the qualified voters of the State of Maryland for their adoption or rejection.

AND I DO CERTIFY that at said election 260,586 votes were cast in favor of Chapter 428 of the Acts of 1966, and 138,420 votes were cast against the adoption of said Chapter 428 of the Acts of 1966, the said Act has therefore been ratified by a majority of the qualified voters of the State of Maryland.
