taxidermists and fur tanning license until expiration of same. Taxidermists and fur tanners shall keep a ledger indicating the number or quantity and species of furs and the county or place of origin in which furs were taken, possessed, bought, sold, transported, shipped, stored, tanned, or used by him. Said ledger shall also include the name, address, and current license number of each person, from whom all furs were purchased within or outside the State of Maryland, the date of purchase, the quantity of each species of furs purchased, the county in which said furs were taken if purchased in the State of Maryland. Said ledger shall cover all transactions from date of issuance of taxidermists and fur tanners license until expiration of same. Said licensee shall at all reasonable hours allow any officer charged with the enforcement of the game and fish laws of this State to enter and inspect the premises where operations are being carried on and to inspect records. [Report forms shall be furnished by the Director.]

[d] Applications for renewal of licenses shall accompany all such reports.]

[(e)] (d) Any person or persons violating any of the provisions of this section shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction before any justice of the peace or a court of Competent jurisdiction shall be fined not less than twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) nor more than fifty dollars (\$50.00) for each and every offense and may be sentenced to thirty (30) days in jail, either or both, at the discretion of the court or justice of the peace before whom said person shall be tried, and in addition to said fine, shall be fined five dollars (\$5.00) for each specimen of wild birds, wild quadruped, or fish or parts thereof mounted or in possession for mounting. All such wild birds, wild quadrupeds, or fish, or parts of wild birds, wild quadrupeds, or fish acquired illegally or being possessed illegally, found in the possession of any person practicing the art of taxidermy and fur tanning, shall be confiscated by the officer making the arrest and turned over to the Director who may dispose of same as he may deem advisable for the best interest of the State. [Any person failing to file a report as required by this Section, or filing a false report, shall have his license revoked for such cause. Any person failing to keep a ledger as required by this section, or make false entries in said ledger, shall have his license revoked for such cause.

SEC. 2. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1967.
