Birds and Game Animals", making it unlawful to hunt from any public road within the boundaries of the Hanover Municipal Water Works property in Carroll County.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Section 132 (g) of Article 66C of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1957 Edition), title "Natural Resources", subtitle "Upland and Migratory Game Birds and Game Animals", be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

132.

- (g) It shall be unlawful to shoot or shoot at any game bird, game animal, fur-bearing animal, wild bird or wild quadruped from an automobile or other vehicle or have in possession in or on an automobile or other vehicle, a loaded shotgun or rifle containing any ammunition in the magazine or chamber. It shall be unlawful to shoot at any game bird, game animal, fur-bearing animal, wild bird, or wild quadruped on, from or across any paved public highway or the shoulder of said highway. It shall be unlawful to shoot from any public highway in Kent County or to hunt from any public road within the boundaries of the Hanover Municipal Water Works property in Carroll County.
- SEC. 2. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1967.

CHAPTER 189

(Senate Bill 640)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Sections 34 (a) and (c) of Article 101 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1964 Replacement Volume), title "Workmen's Compensation", subtitle "Application of Article; Extra-Hazardous Employments", bringing volunteer fire companies and rescue squads of Anne Arundel County within the provisions of the Workmen's Compensation Act, and requiring the County Council of Anne Arundel County to secure compensation to volunteer firemen, or to their dependents in case of death.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Sections 34 (a) and (c) of Article 101 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1964 Replacement Volume), title "Workmen's Compensation", subtitle "Application of Article; Extra-Hazardous Employments", be and they are hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

34.

(a) All members of all volunteer fire companies in Kent, [County and] Howard and Anne Arundel Counties, [County] and all members of all rescue squads in Kent and Anne Arundel Counties,
