## CHAPTER 45

## (Senate Bill 63)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 20 (d) of Article 52 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1966 Supplement), title "Justices of the Peace," subtitle "Criminal Jurisdiction," correcting an error in the laws relating to authorizing trial magistrates in Talbot County to grant probation without verdict in cases involving violation of the law prohibiting possession of alcoholic beverages by minors.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Section 20 (d) of Article 52 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1966 Supplement), title "Justices of the Peace," subtitle "Criminal Jurisdiction," be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

20.

(d) In the case of any person charged with a violation of Section [119 (c)] 118 (c) of Article 2B of this Code, as amended from time to time, (possession of alcoholic beverages by minors), the trial magistrates shall have the power to grant probation without verdict and to make such orders as to probation as are authorized in subsection (a) of this section.

SEC. 2. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1967.

## CHAPTER 46

## (Senate Bill 65)
