CHAPTER 316
(House Bill 883)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 258(b) of Article 56 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1964 Replacement Volume), title "Licenses," subtitle "Home-Improvement Law," subheading "Refusal or revocation of license for untrustworthiness, fraud, bad faith, etc.," to provide that the Maryland Home-Improvement Commission shall not grant a license to any person, nor shall it continue a license already issued, where the Commission finds that the home improvement transactions of the management personnel of the person have been marked by a practice of failure to perform contracts, or by the manipulation of assets or accounts, or by fraud or bad faith.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Section 258(b) of Article 56 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1964 Replacement Volume), title "Licenses," subtitle "Home-Improvement Law," subheading "Refusal or revocation of license for untrustworthiness, fraud, bad faith, etc.," be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, and to read as follows:

258.

For the protection of the people of this State, the Commission shall not grant a license to any person, nor shall it continue a license already issued where the Commission finds that:

(b) the home-improvement transactions of the person, *or the management personnel of the person*, have been marked by a practice of failure to perform contracts, or *by* the manipulation of assets or accounts[;], or by fraud or bad faith.
