## CHAPTER 383 (House Bill 1141)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 20 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Carroll County (1965 Edition, being Article 7 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland), title "Carroll County," subtitle "County Commissioners," in order to change the authorized levy of taxes for certain volunteer fire companies.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Section 20 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Carroll County (1965 Edition, being Article 7 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland), title "Carroll County," subtitle "County Commissioners," be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

The County Commissioners of Carroll County shall annually levy and collect from the assessable property in Carroll County, as other county taxes are levied and collected the sum of  $3\phi$  per \$100.00 of the value of such property, which sum of money the said County Commissioners shall distribute and pay to the several volunteer fire companies in said county for the support, maintenance, equipment (including ambulances) and operation of said volunteer fire companies; and said sum of money shall be proportioned and distributed among said volunteer fire companies upon the recommendation of the executive committee of the Carroll County Volunteer Firemen's Association. The County Commissioners of Carroll County are hereby authorized and empowered, in their discretion and upon the submission to them of a detailed financial report, together with a detailed report of all assets and liabilities, by each volunteer fire company in said county, to increase the annual levy \[ \begin{array}{c} \text{to } 5\phi \end{array} \) up to  $6\phi$  per \\$100.00 of the value of the assessable property in Carroll County, to collect such sum and to distribute it to the several volunteer fire companies in said county as provided in this section.

SEC. 2. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1967.

## CHAPTER 384 (House Bill 1143)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 4A(a) of Article 88A of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1964 Replacement Volume), title "State Department of Public Welfare," subtitle "In General," to add a new member to the Advisory Council on Child Welfare representing the State Department of Juvenile Services and appointed by the Director.
