HE CUSTOMARILY AND REGULARLY RECEIVES MORE THAN \$20 PER MONTH IN TIPS.

Except as may be provided pursuant to this subtitle, every employer shall pay to each of his employees wages at a rate of not less than [\$1.00] \$1.25 an hour.

- (a) EVERY EMPLOYER SHALL PAY TO EACH OF HIS EMPLOYEES, EXCEPT AS MAY BE PROVIDED PURSUANT TO THIS SUBTITLE, WAGES AT THE FOLLOWING RATES:
- (1) IF SUCH EMPLOYEES HAVE BEEN SUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF THE MARYLAND WAGE AND HOUR LAW, AND SECTION 83 OF ARTICLE 100 OF THE ANNOTATED CODE OF MARYLAND PRIOR TO JUNE 1, 1967, THEY SHALL RECEIVE A WAGE OF NOT LESS THAN \$1.15 AN HOUR FROM THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS ACT BEGINNING FEBRUARY 1, 1968, AND NOT LESS THAN \$1.30 AN HOUR BEGINNING JUNE 1, 1968 FEBRUARY 1, 1969.
- (2) ALL EMPLOYEES AS MAY BE SUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SUBTITLE EXCEPT THOSE AS ARE INCLUDED UNDER SECTION 83(1) OF ARTICLE 100 OF THE ANNOTATED CODE OF MARYLAND SHALL RECEIVE A WAGE OF NOT LESS THAN \$1.00 AN HOUR FROM THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS ACT, NOT LESS THAN \$1.15 AN HOUR BEGINNING JUNE 1, 1968, AND NOT LESS THAN \$1.30 AN HOUR BEGINNING JUNE 1, 1969.

(Senate Bill 654)

AN ACT to repeal Sections 417, 418, and 418B through 425, inclusive, of Article 27 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1957 Edition and 1966 Supplement), title "Crimes and Punishments," subtitle "Obscene and Other Objectionable Publications," and to enact new Sections 417, 418, and 419 through 425, inclusive, in lieu thereof, to stand in the place of the sections repealed, to be under the new subtitle "Obscene Matter", generally to revise the laws of the State pertaining to obscene matter; defining and prohibiting the publication, printing, sale and distribution of such
