enroll as a student in any school of cosmetology, such person shall file with the Board a written application for registration, accompanied by a health certificate issued by a registered licensed physician of Maryland, under oath, on a form which shall be prescribed and supplied by such Board and shall deposit with the Board the registration fee, and, except as provided in Section 535, and examination fee, and pass an examination as to fitness to practice or teach cosmetology or to be a demonstrator or manage a beauty shop, as hereinafter provided in this subtitle.

(a) No person shall be permitted by the Board to take an examination to receive a certificate as a Cosmetologist unless such person shall be at least 17 years of age, have an eighth grade education, or its equivalent, and has been registered as a student and has had training as hereinafter provided in this subtitle, in a Beauty School SCHOOL OF COSMETOLOGY duly registered by the Board of at least 1500 hours training. After completion of 1500 hours in a registered school of cosmetology a student is required to complete a State Board Examination in theory only. After successful completion of said examination the student will be issued a Temporary License which entitles him or her to enter a required three month period of practical training in a registered Beauty Salon. Upon certification by Owner Manager of said registered Beauty Salon that the student has completed the necessary practical training the student will then be examined by the Board of Cosmetology on a practical examination. After completing this examination he or she will be issued a license as Cosmetologist.

(b) No person shall be permitted by the Board to take an examination to receive a certificate as a demonstrator who shall not have had all the qualifications necessary to become an operator.

(c) No person shall be permitted by the Board to take an examination to receive a certificate as a junior manager or junior teacher unless such person shall be at least 18 years of age, have a high school education, or its equivalent, and has been registered as a student and has had training as hereinafter provided in this subtitle, in a Beauty School SCHOOL OF COSMETOLOGY duly registered by the Board of at least 2000 hours training inclusive of the studies necessary to become a cosmetologist. After completion of 2000 hours in a registered school of cosmetology the applicant is required to complete a State Board Examination in theory only. After successful completion of said examination the applicant will be issued a Temporary License which entitles him or her to enter the required three month period of practical training in a registered Beauty Salon, or school of cosmetology. Upon certification by Owner Manager of said registered Beauty Salon or the owner of the school that the applicant has completed the necessary practical training; he or she will then be examined by the Board of Cosmetology on a practical examination. After completing this examination he or she will be issued a license as junior manager or junior teacher.

(d) No person shall be permitted by the Board to take an examination to receive a certificate as a senior manager or senior teacher unless such person shall have received a junior manager or junior teacher license as the case may be and has had 1 year's practical experience in either a registered beauty salon or a registered school of cosmetology.
