

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Sections 114(a), 114(b) and 114(c) of Article 66½ of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1967 Replacement Volume), title "Motor Vehicles," subtitle "Administration—Registration—Titling," be and the same are hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:*

114.

(a) Rented to licensed person only.—No person shall rent a motor vehicle *or trailer* to any other person for operation unless the person who will operate such rented motor vehicle *or trailer* is then duly licensed hereunder or, in the case of a non-resident, then duly licensed under the laws of the state of his residence; provided such state requires an examination for qualification to operate a motor vehicle and in which state residents of Maryland are given the same privilege.

(b) Inspection of operator's or chauffeur's license.—No person shall rent a motor vehicle *or trailer* to any other person for operation until the person in the possession of the motor vehicle *or trailer* to be rented has inspected the operator's or chauffeur's license of the person by whom the motor vehicle *or trailer* is to be operated and compared and verified the signature thereon with the signature of such person written in his presence *and compared and verified the physical description thereon with the physical description of such person.*

(c) Record.—Every person renting a motor vehicle *or trailer* to another shall keep a record of the registration number of the motor vehicle *or trailer* so rented OR, WHEN ONLY A TRAILER IS RENTED, THE REGISTRATION NUMBER OF THE TRAILER AND THE MOTOR VEHICLE WHICH SHALL BE USED TO HAUL SUCH TRAILER, the name and address of the person to whom the motor vehicle *or trailer* is rented, the number of the operator's license of the person who is to operate the said motor vehicle *or HAUL THE trailer* and the date and place ~~and when and where said license was issued~~ OF ISSUANCE OF THE SAID OPERATOR'S LICENSE. Such record shall be open to inspection by any peace officer or officer or employee of the Department.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1968.*

CHAPTER 639

(House Bill 116)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 40(q) of Article 10 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1967 Supplement), title "Attorney at Law and Attorneys in Fact," subtitle "State's Attorney," pertaining only to Prince George's County, to
