- (1) The clerk shall mail a notice to each owner of a lot or parcel of land within the conversion district advising him of the provisions of subsection (k) and stating that unless such owner complies with the requirements of such section subsection all buildings, structures and improvements located upon the lot or parcel will be subject to disconnection from the electric or communication facilities providing service thereto. Such notice shall be mailed at least fifteen days prior to the date of commencement of construction and shall be mailed to the owners whose names and addresses appear on the last assessment roll, used by the county or incorporated municipality or as known to the clerk.
- SEC. 2. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1968.

CHAPTER 12

(Senate Bill 63)

- (a) The State Roads Commission, in addition to its other duties and powers provided by law, and notwithstanding any provisions to the contrary in [Article] Articles 73B, 77 and 88B of the Annotated Code of Maryland or any other statute, is authorized to purchase real property that it deems will be necessary for future improvement of the State highway system by the following method:
