new owner or owners also transfer said tangible personal property or stock in business prior to the said semiannual date of finality next following said transfer; provided, however, that nothing in this sentence shall apply to any tangible personal property or stock in business removed from the State prior to the said semiannual date of finality. In the case of a transfer of personal property where the owner of the property has paid taxes upon it under this subsection, the transferor is entitled to require the transferee to adjust the amount of taxes so paid between them.

SEC. 2. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1968.

## CHAPTER 123

(Senate Bill 214)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 211(a) of Article 77 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1965 Replacement Volume), title "Public Education," subtitle "Chapter 18. High Schools," providing that individuals 17 years of age or older may qualify for the high school equivalent certificate provided that they have been withdrawn from a regular full-time public or private school for at least six months.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Section 211(a) of Article 77 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1965 Replacement Volume), title "Public Education," subtitle "Chapter 18. High Schools," be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

## 211.

(a) Any person who has not obtained a high school certificate or diploma and who has resided in Maryland or on a federal reservation within the State of Maryland for at least one year and (1) who is [19] 17 years of age or older and has been withdrawn from a regular full-time public or private school program for at least six months, or (2) who is a member of the armed forces of the United States and is 17 years of age or older, may obtain an equivalent certificate in accordance with this section.

SEC. 2. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1968.

## CHAPTER 124

(Senate Bill 222)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 360(b) of Article 41 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1965 Replace-
