- (b) The membership of the Commission is composed of eleven (11) THIRTEEN (13) persons, chosen or specified as follows: The President of the Senate of Maryland; the Speaker of the House of Delegates of Maryland; the Director of State Planning for Maryland; the State Senator SENATORS for fanne Arundel County the district encompassing the City of Annapolis; the mayor of the City of Annapolis; the county executive of Anna Arundel County; the superintendent of the United States Naval Academy at Annapolis; and four persons to be appointed by the Governor of Maryland of which one he shall designate as chairman of the Commission.

(Senate Bill 238)

(b) For the school year 1967-68 and thereafter, each county and Baltimore City shall be entitled to and shall be paid by the State of Maryland each year in the manner and subject to the limitations hereinafter provided an amount to be known as school building construction aid which shall be calculated as follows:
