(House Joint Resolution 52)

House Joint Resolution requesting the County Commissioners of Harford County to appoint a committee of interested citizens to work with the Harford County Board of Parks and Recreation in the preparation of a twenty-year program for the financing and building of public swimming pools in the County.

WHEREAS, As a county which is rapidly growing in population, Harford County is experiencing a shortage of recreational facilities for its citizens, including swimming pools; and

WHEREAS, It is in the interest of the physical and mental health, fitness and joy of the people of Harford County to have reasonable access to public swimming pools; now, therefore, be it

*Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the County Commissioners of Harford County are requested to appoint a committee of eight interested persons to embark upon a joint study with the Harford County Board of Parks and Recreation in order to develop a plan for the installation of public swimming pools in a progressive manner over the next twenty years, locating same in appropriate areas of the county and recommending a means of financing such pools; and be it further

*Resolved*, That the Committee is requested to submit its recommendations to the members of the General Assembly elected from Harford County by January 1, 1969; and be it further

*Resolved*, That copies of this Resolution are sent to the Board of County Commissioners of Harford County and to the Board of Parks and Recreation.
